Join the DCMSA and DCMSAF as it hosts a bicycle ride and family fun run at the Cottonwood Trail Extension of the Whiterock Trail. This is a fund-raising event for the Medical Alliance. Riders will begin their trek at the Willowdell Park Site area (near Forest and Central Expressway). Joggers, walkers and runners of all ages will head north for a 3 mile route on the new trail extension. Children 12 and under will look for healthy clues that will direct them to their next fun task. The first one to complete all challenges and find all clues on their card, will win a donated prize.

Accomplished/advanced adult bicycle riders will head south on the trail and ride 10 miles round trip on the trails toward Northwest Highway and back. No streets will be crossed in the ride. For the last two years they have participated in our Community Health Fair.

for this disease. Diabetes is the name given to disorders in which the body has trouble regulating its blood glucose, or blood sugar, levels. There are two major types of diabetes: type 1 and type 2. Type 1 diabetes (T1D) is an autoimmune disease in which a person's pancreas stops producing insulin, a hormone that enables people to get energy from food. Type 2 diabetes is a metabolic disorder in which a person's body still produces insulin but is unable to use it effectively.

Volunteers will be needed to man the checkin table from 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. We also need volunteers to help set up tables the day of the race. Volunteers will also be needed to help sort jerseys and t-shirts and packets for the participants the day before the race.


